How It Works

With our custom plug transplant program, you choose the plants and we do the growing.

- 1** Provide us with organic and/or untreated, non-GMO seed (with a non-GMO verification statement) from sourced seed companies.
- 2** Pick your transplant date.
- 3** Wozupi Tribal Gardens turns your seeds into plant starts, ready for transplant to your farm or market garden. We will grow trays of 128, 72, or 50 cells (your choice).



About Wozupi Tribal Gardens

Wozupi is an organic farm committed to growing food in a way that nourishes the earth, the community, and people's minds and bodies. The farm grows vegetables, herbs, and fruit, produces maple syrup, and uses honeybees to pollinate the plants. All Wozupi produce is USDA-certified organic.

Wozupi is owned and operated by the Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community, a federally recognized, sovereign Native American tribe located southwest of Minneapolis/St. Paul. Since opening in 2010, Wozupi, which means "garden" in the Dakota Language, has encompassed the tribe's focus on being a good neighbor, good employer, and good steward of the earth.

FAQs

Can I order a split or partial flat?

No. We only sell full flats at regular price.

Can I purchase more plants from your retail plant list?

Of course! You may purchase our retail-ready plants at our retail-ready pricing online at **wozupi.com**, over the phone, or by email.

Do you offer additional flat sizes (besides 128, 72, or 50 cell trays)?

Yes. 10-by-20-inch open flats of alliums can be custom grown for on-site pickup only. No other tray sizes are available.

Do I have to place my order online?

Although we prefer online orders at **wozupi.com**, you can order by fax, email, or phone.

How do I provide proof of organic certification to my certifier?

Our greenhouses are certified organic by the Midwest Organic Services Association (MOSA), and we are listed as an organic producer on MOSA's website (mosaorganic.org). Organic status of our retail-ready plants are indicated on your invoice, too. We will provide a copy of our organic certificate to customers who need this verification.

Countdown to FIELD TRANSPLANTING

9 WEEKS BEFORE

Plan your plant quantities, varieties, and field transplant dates per crop. Place your order with Wozupi Tribal Gardens and submit a down payment of 50 percent.

7 WEEKS BEFORE

Return the growers agreement with terms and conditions, along with your seeds and seed receipts at least 7 weeks prior to the field transplant date.*

4-6 WEEKS BEFORE

We seed your plants in the greenhouse, according to your predetermined field transplant date.

1 WEEK BEFORE

We confirm the date of delivery/pickup and request any remaining balance due. Requests for delayed shipment or pickup can be arranged at this time, for an additional \$2 per flat per week with a 24-hour delayed pickup grace period.

TIME TO TRANSPLANT!

Either we ship your plants during your designated field transplant week or you pick them up on a predetermined date. Then, you enjoy the fruits of less labor-intensive growing! We guarantee that all plants will be healthy upon shipment/pickup. Please see the terms and conditions for more details.

Additional Fees

- Fee for exceeding six-week growing cycle in greenhouse: \$2 per flat (excluding alliums)
- Fee for customer-requested and/or delinquent pickup or shipment: \$2 per flat
- Top-dress fertility fee per week for plants held for more than seven weeks (including per customer request): \$1 per flat

DELIVERY

Pickup at the Farm

You can pick up your plants at Wozupi Tribal Gardens Tuesday or Wednesday of your scheduled transplant week. All outstanding balances must be paid in full before pickup. Plant boxes can be purchased for \$5 each at the farm that can securely hold three stacked plant flats.

Parcel Shipping and Handling

You can estimate \$5 per flat or for every five bare root bundles of alliums and/or \$15 per plant box that will hold three flats securely for shipment via Spee-Dee Delivery. Exact shipping fees will be calculated and invoiced accordingly.

LTL Pallet Freight

Pallet freight options are available for larger orders via Spee-Dee Delivery. You can estimate that a pallet fits 45 flats at a cost of \$120 to \$150 per delivery location per full pallet (\$2.66 to \$3.33 per flat for a full pallet).

We do our best to find you the most favorable shipping rates for your order. Rates listed above are estimates based on current fuel surcharges and Spee-Dee Delivery shipping rates. Your invoice will reflect actual shipping and handling costs at time of delivery.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Limit of Liability

All plants are guaranteed to be healthy upon shipment and/or scheduled pickup date. All plants are guaranteed to be true to name. All orders are subject to natural disasters, crop failures, or conditions beyond Wozupi Tribal Gardens' control. It is agreed between Wozupi Tribal Gardens and all custom starter plug program customers that Wozupi Tribal Gardens' liability is strictly limited to replacement or credit of plants if plant failures are a result of conditions within Wozupi Tribal Gardens' control. Once plants have been picked up by customers or shipped, Wozupi Tribal Gardens does not guarantee or warranty plant vigor, health, or survival. As Wozupi Tribal Gardens cannot control the conditions and plant handling outside of our greenhouse, Wozupi Tribal Gardens makes no warranty, expressed or implied, including any warranty of fitness for any particular purpose with respect to plant stock and no other warranties are extended to our custom starter plug program customers.

Pickup

Plants are to be picked up/shipped on the designated date determined by all custom order transplant dates. All plants held at the customer's request beyond the scheduled pickup or delivery date will incur a weekly holding charge of \$2.00 per flat per week with a 24-hour grace period from scheduled pickup date. Guarantee of plant health and vigor is not extended by Wozupi Tribal Gardens to late pickups/deliveries made at customer request and customer shall bear the sole risk of loss.

Shipping

All orders of healthy, vigorous plants will be shipped via Spee-Dee Delivery outside of the Twin Cities metro area unless other arrangements have been made by customer with Wozupi Tribal Gardens. All deliveries shipped hereunder are F.O.B. Shipping Point. Wozupi Tribal Gardens is not liable for any plant injury, loss, insects, or disease incurred through shipment. Customers assume all risk of loss and shipping expenses.

Seeds and Trays

Customers will send Wozupi Tribal Gardens commercially packaged, certified organic, and/or untreated seed. All seeds must be germ tested by the seed company within 6 months of the actual seeding date for all custom production. Wozupi Tribal Gardens reserves the right to refuse any treated or GMO seeds. A non-GMO verification statement from each seed company used must be included with any non-organic seed. Low germination tested seeds (79%-) resulting in insufficient transplants is the sole responsibility of the customer, and customers should factor in potential low germination rates of tested seed when placing orders and plan accordingly. Wozupi Tribal Gardens guarantees 90% germination on all new, high germ tested seed (80%+) but customers must send 20% extra seed per plant variety in order to meet that guarantee (at least 115 plants for every 128 cell flat, 65 plants per 72 cell flat, and 45 plants per 50 cell flat). It is the customer's responsibility to plan accordingly. All partial trays due to low germ tested seed or insufficient seed provided by customer will be charged at full flat price. NO SPLIT FLAT ORDERS ACCEPTED. Leftover seeds will be returned to customer at time of pickup or will be shipped with orders. Any unclaimed seed after pickup or delivery becomes the property of Wozupi Tribal Gardens.

Refund Policy

Refunds for custom plug orders will be granted for 50% only if Wozupi Tribal Gardens is given notice of order cancellation no later than 1 week prior to greenhouse seeding date. No refunds will be issued on orders after the greenhouse seeding date has passed.
